What is Children's Rehabilitative Services (CRS)?

CRS is a designation given to AHCCCS members who have ongoing qualifying health conditions.

Does my child need AHCCCS insurance to have a CRS designation?

- Yes, the CRS designation is only assigned to members enrolled in an AHCCCS health plan and under 21 years of age.
- Apply for AHCCCS health insurance here: Health-e-Arizona (healthearizonaplus.gov)

Who can fill out a CRS application?

Anyone can fill out a CRS application including a parent, guardian, family member, doctor or health plan representative.

What are the benefits of CRS?

- Members can get medical and behavioral health services at clinics called Multispecialty Interdisciplinary Clinics (MSICs).
- MSICs have several specialty providers in one office to make scheduling of appointments easier.
- MSICs partner with community agencies to help support any and all member and family needs.
- CRS members can also receive support through their enrolled health plan.
